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1. Nature, Environment, Climate

Educational, Advisory, Motivating, Exemplary: We Stand for a Consistent Environmental Policy!

*“We would like to leave our children and children’s children a world worth living”
(CSV Hesper)*

In our opinion, the protection of the environment, nature and climate is one of the municipalities’ most crucial tasks. It must make full use of its limited scope for action on its own initiative or in association with the national bodies and organizations, the inter-municipal syndicates, as well as with potential private initiatives.

The ever-increasing role that the municipality gets to play in this area places it in the role of mediator between all these partners and the citizen, with an educational, advisory and motivation task.

A municipality must also lead by the example, with an own sustainable infrastructure and approach.

“Less fossil, more renewable”: we base our climate protection policy on this principle. The solution to the climate problem rises and falls with the energy issue. The set of possibilities that we want to give ourselves is consistent.

In addition to the deepening of the consultation and the awareness rising of the population from childhood and the expansion of the bonus spectrum for renewable energy projects, we also see the municipality in the active task of action.



We propose

- a multiplication of photovoltaic systems, in addition to the current 17 installations on municipal buildings,
- the purchase of renewable energy in an interregional context,
- the opportunity assessment for small windmills,
- an optimal use of wood waste from our forests, e.g. for heating and construction purposes,
- the systematic use of geothermal heat, ice storage and air heat pumps,
- a systematic insulation of new municipal buildings and the energetic renovation of various existing infrastructures,
- the expansion of the analytical energy consumption- and cost control,
- the continuation of the present sustainable building policy according to circular economy criteria, as seen for the new Howald school, which was awarded the DGNB platinum certificate for sustainable construction, with a result of 87.2%. The expansion of the CIPA should also be conceived in this way,
- more support for ecological mobility through additional charging stations, the installation of a fast charger and the further development of the municipal fleet according to renewable energy criteria.

Nature and environmental protection includes a whole range of aspects.

Living in a mixed urban-rural environment with large recreation areas, we have to take in account a number of very specific problems, such as water protection or waste management.

We propose

- the continuation of the renaturation of our creeks and rivers and the consolidation of the current construction policy, with the established retention obligations in the affected specific layout plans (PAPs) and the mandatory retention basins in the elder districts,
- the use of non-potable water to irrigate communal areas,
- a permanent monitoring of drinking water- and air quality,
- urban planning measures and natural buffer measures including traffic and noise reduction,
- in the context of biodiversity, climate change and heat protection

- landscaping of the exposed spaces with trees and plants,
- a species-appropriate management of forests, also in the context of fire prevention,
- measures against invasive and alien plant species
- the promotion of local fruit, vegetables, hedges and flowers planting, as part of the project “Giele Band”
- the prohibition of genetically engineered crops on municipal land,
- the implementation of the garden project “Um Kiemert” in Itzig,
- an insect-friendly soil management without pesticides, insecticides, fungicides and herbicides,
- a forest learning path for children,
- the consolidation of Hesperange as an agrarian-friendly municipality through long-rooted farm businesses that ensure optimal landscape maintenance and the production of healthy and quality products,
- a healthy diet, especially in the daycare center, in which fair trade and local or regional organic products should be proposed as a priority,
- an anti-gaspi management of the canteens. We would like to establish partnerships with external actors in view of the recycling of the remains,
- adequate advice to the population on waste disposal through the “Oekozer” which has a real resource center vocation,
- the recycling of collected cigarette butts,
- the further development of our “Öekozer”, with the expansion of the second hand shop on the site, the relaunch of the Repair Café several times a year and the installation of small resource centers in various buildings,
- the promotion of the waste separation policy, coupled with a tiered waste tax system, respectively the distribution of chipped waste bins,
- the introduction of mandatory systematic triage in all public buildings, at public events and in apartment buildings.

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2. Sports, Culture, Leisure

Culture, Sports and Leisure: Concrete for Social Cohesion!

“We want to shape cultural, sports and leisure activities in an intergenerational and multicultural optic, in such a way that they bring together the people of our municipality.”
(CSV Hesper)

In recent years, the municipality of Hesperange has built up a complete and interesting range of cultural, leisure and sports infrastructures and activities. It must now do justice to the new socio-demographic challenges through an adjusted offer in all localities.

This means that citizens, regardless of their living place, must have easy access to culture and sports and can benefit directly from our local recreation areas.

It applies both to the infrastructure and to the specific range of activities.

We see the municipality, but also our associations, in an active role to achieve this goal.

We propose

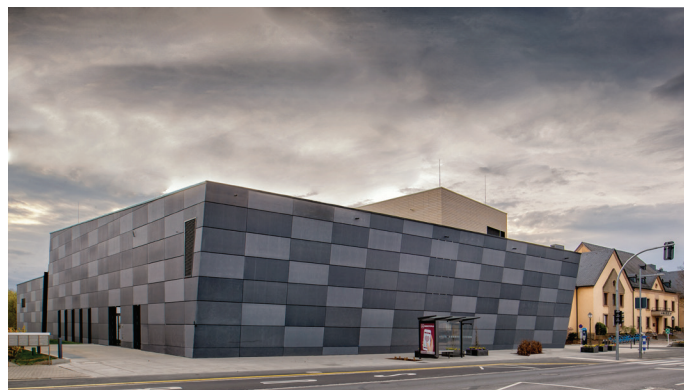
- an upgrade of the community hall in Itzig,
- the creation of small meeting infrastructures in Alzingen, Fentange and Howald,
- the use of the church of Howald for cultural purposes,
- the greening of playgrounds and meeting points, with additional seating and trees that provide shade in summer,
- the establishment of picnic areas in suitable places,
- the creation of meeting places with WLAN hotspot networking, suitable for young people at public multi-sports facilities, at the skate park or other suitable locations,
- dog walking areas at various locations in the municipality,
- a development and expansion of leisure infrastructure on and around the campsite;
- the erection of a canopy walk;
- the construction of new large sports infrastructures such as a public swimming pool and a new tennis center,
- a new synthetic football field in Itzig, “an den Espen” and the upgrade of the Stade Alphone Theis,
- more fitness courts and trails throughout the municipality,
- new theme playgrounds and the disabled-friendly design of the existing playgrounds.

Nonetheless, modern infrastructures also need to be invigorated. The municipality finances the infrastructure, supports the clubs with subsidies and logistics and also organizes her own events.

The clubs have however a decisive influence on the cultural, sports and leisure time calendar.

We propose

- bringing the associations together for a consultation in order to better coordinate activities and to be able to provide them with information-oriented support, as well as to dynamize the association platform Orga 50,
- to assign a cultural coordinator or a sports coordinator to the clubs,
- a concrete public support for academic, cultural and sporting achievements,
- a decentralization of the general offer of the various sports courses,
- the expansion of the target group for “Hesper beweegt sech”, in the spirit of greater inclusion, in order to also reach the children who are not enrolled in the schools of our municipality,
- the reinvigoration of the “Wanter Flair” and “Kultur Summer” events, with a revival of “Rock am Park”,
- a better involvement of young people in decision-making through a systematic participation offer for the various commissions,
- a re-centring of the CELO cultural program once the new complementary civic center is completed,
- a general decentralization of the cultural offer, e.g. through concerts on a traveling stage or exhibitions in all locations of the municipality



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3. Mobility

Well connected, fluid, safe, sustainable: our vision of mobility!

“Hesperange must stay connected, without suffocating in traffic” (CSV Hesperange)

The geographical location of our municipality in the heart of the capital's catchment area has advantages, but it is also suffering from a significant flow of regional transit traffic, which invades us from all sides at peak times.

This bottleneck problem not only has a negative impact on the quality of life, but also on the economic and ecological balance sheet.

The Hesperange bypass has been discussed for years. This essential project in which we want to continue to invest ourselves in a constructive and insistent manner, in contact with the responsible institutions, must be carried out by the government as soon as possible.

This remains a political priority for us.

The bypass will likely help narrow the problem, but it won't fix it permanently. That's why today we want to make additional long-term arrangements, such as traffic calming measures and P&Rs directly linked to the bus and rail networks.

Infrastructure and municipal mobility offers must also be aligned according to intergenerational, social and sustainability criteria, with a particular emphasis on soft mobility.

- through an even larger “vel’Oh” offer
- with the provision of additional “M-Boxes”
- by providing covered and functional scooter and bicycle racks, especially near the schools and bus stops
- through a concept study on the creation of a “Bike-bus” for school children.
- sidewalks and secure pedestrian crossings on the main and secondary axes,
- a continuous development of the „Séchere Schoulwée“ project and the „Pedibus“ Service,
- the development of public transport
 - with the new “Citybus” which offers a modulated service throughout the municipality
 - by expanding the “Flexibus” offer, in particular for connections to hospitals in the outskirts
 - by a good availability of the “Nightrider” and “Late Night Bus” services
 - with the connection of the RGTR network to the future Howald peripheral station.



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We propose

- the expansion of car sharing and electromobility infrastructures (in particular the Chargy network),
- the improvement of the situation of cyclists
 - by the construction of the currently planned cycle paths
 - by the implementation of additional cycle paths and the development of secure cycle infrastructures to connect the localities and the various districts of the municipality

Public safety, quality of life and various ecological factors, such as CO2 gas emissions and noise, require the implementation of structural and regulatory measures to slow down traffic, ensure road safety and maintain traffic fluidity.

We propose

- selective adjustments to 30km/h speed areas through adapted road layouts,
- the development and ecologization of major roads like the N3,
- the development of “Shared Space” zones in locality centers and in front of Schools,
- the use of educational traffic cams in crucial places, such as near schools,
- the construction of a bicycle training infrastructure for children,
- the creation of a Cycling School and a Cycling House, which will not only fulfill preventive missions, but also support the promotion, inform, as well as provide bicycle rental and repair,
- the revision of the “Residential Parking” concept,
- the review and mitigation of all hazardous intersections in the municipality.

Road construction, in particular underground infrastructure works, generally has a negative impact on the daily lives of residents and on the traffic flow, especially during the construction phases.

These investments in water supply and sanitation networks, as well as in energy and telecommunications structures, must however be made in the interest of maintaining the optimum quality of life.



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We propose

- a good organization of municipal bodies to ensure the best possible coordination with the road construction authority and the other bodies involved,
- a development respecting the habitability criteria of the Howald district, within the framework of the connection to the new interchange station, by new road layouts and the development of the necessary infrastructures.

4. Social

Well Connected, Available, Supportive: Good Living in Hesperange!

*“We want the social network to be so intertwined that no one falls through the cracks”
(CSV Hesper)*

In a municipality like ours, where around 54% of the residents are non-Luxembourgish, one third are under 25 and one fifth are over 60, social co-existence should be harmonious.

In our opinion everybody should be addressed and everyone should talk to each other on the one hand, but on the other each should also take care of the other, with a special attention to those who are alone, those who live with a handicap or those who are socially disadvantaged. We stand for a comprehensive intergenerational, multicultural and responsible social policy.

Almost one third of the people who live in Hesperange are singles. Over 40% live in a family with or without children. Around 8% are single mothers or fathers. The community's social offer must take into account all these lifestyles.

We propose

- decentralized school infrastructures, close to the families, with a suitable infrastructural framework: daycare centers, nurseries and forest school classes,
- an adequately decentralized municipal activity offer in the school periphery, in association with our clubs,
- nicely arranged and easily accessible meeting points, with park benches, for young people and elderlies, throughout the whole municipality,
- a festival calendar with varied events that bring the whole population together,
- aid structures for disadvantaged fellow citizens: a shelter for women in need with children, assisted housing for young people, the deployment of street workers, senior housing, disabled-friendly playgrounds and accessible buildings for people with limited mobility.

The population under 25 exceeds the 4,000 mark in our municipality. Those youngsters have very specific societal needs. It is important that they feel part of the community in the long term.

We propose

- a proactive design of the youth work around the Youth Center, with the aim to also reach young people who are not educated in Hesperange,
- targeted information through the Youth-Guide and theme conferences,
- a preparation for professional life through student jobs, volunteering and the “Youth and Work” initiative,
- the continuation of the “round table” concept to boost the dialogue between all involved actors.



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Around every fifth of our citizens is over 60 years old. In Hesperange seniors should be able to fall back on a diverse, interesting, intergenerational and multicultural offer of infrastructures and initiatives that help them shape their lives in an active, comfortable and safe way.

We propose

- the expansion of the care offer for the CIPA nursing home,
- the diversification of the leisure activities range at the clubhouse “Am Säitert”,
- a consistent information policy through an adequate dissemination of the “Guide-Senior”, publication and thematic information meetings or brochures, which could be laid out in the medical center to reach the most isolated people,



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- consistent practical life support through the CIGL, the Telealarm system and the neighborhood social app HOPLR,
- the promotion of a coordinated collaboration with all other actors from the sector.

Health and safety are two essential settings for good quality of life and well-being.

It is the task of the municipality to shape and organize these two factors in such a way that health care is secured and promoted and that the positive objective and subjective security perception remains preserved.

We propose

- the diversification of the specialized medical offer in the framework of the “Medical Centers”, as well as the securing of a decent general health offer in the municipality,
- the promotion of an infrastructural and active leisure offer that supports health, through cycling tracks, fitness courses and places, hiking trails, sports courses and of course the promotion of the “Hesper bewegt sech” initiative,
- the organization of first-aid courses (basic and mental health),
- the preservation of the security bodies in the municipality: Police, Fire and Rescue,
- the restructuring of the Municipal Agent Service into a Proximity Service, which will result in a greater presence of our agents on the ground, so that they can better deal with minor incivility.

No means should be left unused: online via internet, Facebook, Instagram, YouTube and mobile application, via traditional means (official billboarding, meetings, printed documents), phone or through direct personal physical contact.

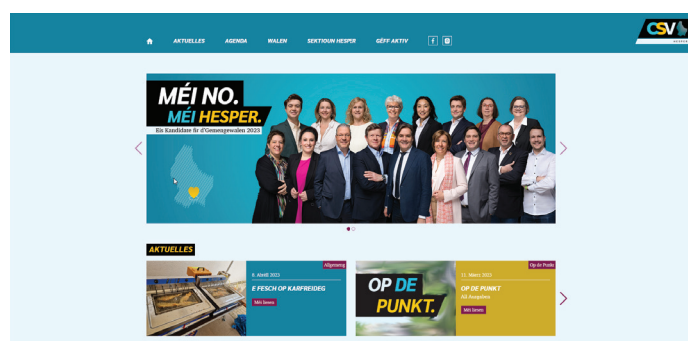
This offer of dialogue should also be extended to people who have just moved into the municipality and who therefore need a certain orientation.

The choice of language is an essential element of intelligibility and inclusion.

The municipality must communicate clearly and verifiably in Luxembourgish, French, English and if necessary, depending on the subject and the target audience, also in a fourth language, in compliance with the provisions relating to data protection and confidentiality.

We propose

- the setting up of a multilingual website to make your access to all important documents and services even more interactive and attractive, with podcasts or the live broadcast of municipal council meetings,
- the creation of a new mobile application: inclusive, interactive, accessible 24/7, offering service information, general news, an agenda and a push service for urgent news in real time,
- an official digital display ("Reider") for all sections of the municipality,
- information sessions on key topics,
- online thematic webinars for all those who cannot physically attend the meetings.



The digitization of our communication is inevitable. However, it must be limited to realistic scenarios, within the limits of municipal jurisdiction, existing laws and user-friendliness.

Our idea of municipal digital development, in the zeitgeist, means that our municipality can be counted among the most progressive and modern in the country.

We defend progress and thus want to advance digitalization in all municipal activities.

Digital

- is complementary to existing traditional means,
- operates 24 hours a day,
- helps to reach a wider audience,
- energizes more interactive approaches,
- saves paper,

- simplifies administrative procedures,
- is secure, provided that all appropriate measures have been taken.

We propose

- the establishment of a clear and transparent contact platform,
- a one-stop shop that facilitates citizens' access to administrative procedures,
- expanding the offer of online forms for the benefit of associations and citizens,
- an increase in the staff of the IT department to guarantee permanent and optimal monitoring of all digital security parameters,
- the extension of the municipal offer of online services, with for example an improvement in the IT offer for school education,
- the systematic use of the Orga50 platform to boost digital interactivity with associations,
- a permanent adaptation and improvement of our Helpdesk, which must be able to provide friendly and clear answers to the public in case of problem or question.



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6. Urban Planning, Infrastructures,

Affordable Housing

Coordinated growth: we create living space for everyone!

*“The municipality of Hesperange must remain lively and not become a dormitory town”
(CSV-Hesper)*

Safeguarding our orderly growth and organizing harmonious coexistence are prerequisites for a careful and sustainable urban concept, for the creation of affordable housing and the provision of comprehensive infrastructure.

This is a major and vital challenge that arises for the management of a municipality where building land is scarce, where the housing problem, as in other municipalities, can only be subsidiarily tackled and where population growth presents itself in a constant and multicultural but varied way, according to the geographical situation.

- and the expansion of the water network,
- the reconstruction and development of rue des Scillas in Howald, in the context of the municipal connection of the tramway network,
- the planning of a forest cemetery and a pet cemetery as well as the permanent maintenance of our peaceful final resting places.

Quality of life depends on good social infrastructures. It is our goal to approach this subject in an inclusive and decentralized way.



We propose

- a participatory workshop, with the citizens of Howald, to exchange and collect ideas on the development of the center of Howald, with a view to the construction of a shared space meeting point for all people living in the locality,
- the adjustment of the general urbanistic layout plan (PAG), where it is possible, in respect of the balance between environment and living comfort,
- the use of currently unused building land,
- the creation of affordable housing, in collaboration with partners such as the Housing Fund, the SNHBM, the Social Housing Agency and Caritas,
- the implementation of projects that consider local trade and promote our local businesses, to better link our residents to the community and to maintain local employment through an attractive life offer,
- the maintenance and permanent adaptation of civil engineering sanitary infrastructures to keep sanitation, water and energy networks as well as the telecommunications up to date,
- the construction of a new wastewater treatment plant



We propose

- the continuous development of school and supervision structures, e.g. in Howald, Alzingen and Fentange,
- the development of existing or new activity zones;
- the realization of the Place Jomé project, including a car park and an elevator to “Holleschbiérg”, a project which by the way also provides affordable housing and space for local businesses as well as a new medical center,
- the construction of “Tiny Houses” on suitable sites,
- the development of infrastructures and meeting points frequented by young people,
- the environmentally friendly extension of CIPA - Howald and the continued offer development of the Senior Club-House “am Säitert”,
- the establishment of assisted housing structures for young and elderly people in need.

We want our municipality to become even more attractive and that the quality service offers to the population, at the cultural, sporting and leisure level, constantly improve. This is why we need adequate infrastructure.

We propose

- the development of “Haus Baumert”, on the castle site, as a local history center,
- the construction of safe cycle and pedestrian paths,
- an environmentally friendly mobility network interconnecting all localities of the municipality as such favoring social contact between the inhabitants,
- a committed and permanent monitoring of the Hesperange bypass project.
